

Elkin Middle School Grading Policy

We want all students to be successful and make the most of the academics at Elkin Middle School. We expect students to be responsible and complete and turn in homework assignments in a timely manner. Students who are having difficulty can stay for tutoring on Tuesday, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Tutoring offers a lower ratio of students to teacher and allows for more individualized instruction and review. Please read the grading policy and discuss the requirements with your child. Parents and students are asked to complete and return the bottom portion of this form during the first week of school. Please keep the top portion for your records.

Grading Policy for Daily Homework:

1. Homework is due on the assigned date during the assigned class period.
2. Homework that is turned in one day late will be accepted for a maximum of 50% credit. (The student must complete the work and have everything correct to receive 50% credit. Work that is incomplete will not be accepted)
3. Please remember that students are required to have 90% of all homework completed each 9 weeks to qualify for Ace Club. Ace Club is a quarterly reward activity for students who complete work, have good attendance and do not have office referrals during a 9 week period.

Grading Policy for Long-Term Assignments and Projects:

1. Projects and long-term assignments are due on the assigned date during the assigned class period.
2. Projects or long-term assignments that are turned in late will be graded with the student losing 10% of the grade each day for 5 days. After 5 days the project or long-term assignment will not be accepted. (Example: If a project was worth 100 points and the student turned it in one day late the student's maximum grade would be 90 with any deductions taken from the 90. On the second day late the student's maximum grade would be 80 with deductions taken from the 80.

3. Projects and long-term assignments will also be calculated into the 90% completion of homework for students to be able to earn the Ace Club reward at the end of the 9 weeks.

Extra Credit:

Extra Credit will NOT be offered unless a student is failing a subject AND the student has completed all homework and projects for the class.

Daily Homework is considered homework assigned in class that is to be completed by the next school day.

Long-term and projects are considered to be assignments that may take 2 or more days to complete.
